

HIGH WORK PERMIT

This High Work Permit form must be completed by the area supervisor (or his / her designee)

whenever: High work is to be performed within 15 feet of unprotected sides and edges, leading edges, unprotected holes and roofs that are 6 feet or more above an adjacent lower level;

Fixed fall protection systems are not available; and

The use of portable manlifts, stairs or ladders in conjunction with appropriate fall arrest systems or fall restraint systems is infeasible.

INSTRUCTIONS

- The supervisor of the employee(s) performing the high work (or his / her designee) must complete all but the last section of this form.
- 2. The completed form must be retained by the employee(s) performing the high work at the job site until the work is completed.
- After the high work is completed, the completed form must be returned by the employee(s) performing the high work to the supervisor (or his / her designee).
- After the high work is completed, the supervisor (or his / her designee) must complete the last section of this form and forward the completed form to the Manager, Occupational Health and Safety (MOHS).
- The MOHS will retain the completed High Work Permit for no less than five (5) years.
