1. Summary

This report provides a statistical analysis of the Trumbull Campus enrollment for the Summer I&II 11 Term. The Trumbull Campus experienced a 37.60% increase in student headcount; 1,431 students in Summer I&II 11 compared to 1,040 students in Summer I&II 10 for a net increase of 391 students. Undergraduate enrollment increased by 38.10% (394 students) and graduate enrollment decreased by 50% (-3 students).

Student FTE increase by 32.90%; the Trumbull Campus generated 46.13 more FTE compared to Summer I&II 10. Undergraduate FTE increased by 33.42% (46.57 FTE) and graduate FTE decreased by 50.57% (-0.44 FTE).

The undergraduate mean unit load (MUL) is 1.95 compared to 2.02 in Summer I&II 10. Graduate MUL is 2.17 compared to last year's 2.17 and the campus MUL is 1.95 compared to 2.02 last year.

Note: During Spring and Fall terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 15; during Summer terms, FTE is the students' total credit hours divided by 30.
